## 2021–2022 TASC District III Scholarship Application

In recognition of the contributions of many students to the Student Council programs, the TASC District III will recognize at least five outstanding graduating seniors with college scholarships. The amount of each scholarship will be \$750. Schools may nominate a maximum of two applicants. Student(s) nominated must meet the following criteria to be considered.

- 1. The student must be a senior member of the student council, with a minimum of two consecutive years on the council.
- 2. The application should reflect ONLY student council activities.
- 3. The student must have a cumulative grade average of 85 for seven semesters through January 20, 2022.
- 4. The student must enroll in the summer or fall following graduation in an accredited institution of higher education.
- 5. The student must fully complete the official application with transcript and required attachments. Form and attachments must be submitted in one document by advisor no later than January 20, 2022 to <a href="https://tinyurl.com/D3SeniorScholarshipSubmission">https://tinyurl.com/D3SeniorScholarshipSubmission</a>.

All applications received will be judged by the Scholarship Committee using the following point system:

The top applicants (application = 40%; interview = 60%) will be interviewed at the District Spring Conference, with payment of the scholarship deferred until proof of enrollment in college is submitted to TASC District III. Scholarships will be paid directly to the school.

Application is due January 20, 2022 to be uploaded by completing the <u>District 3 Senior Submission Form</u>. District III only accepts electronic submission of forms. Form and any attachments, with required signatures, must be submitted in one document.
